CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. M. Hill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Creek through reservoir, dam, flume and pipelines for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18, T. 9 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears N. 71° 45' E. 670.96 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46 Statutes of 1957 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Naval Ammunition Depot
Post-office address: Hawthorne, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.01 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 2, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Cottonwood Creek by means of a collection basin and concrete dam, whence the water is conveyed through a Parshall flume and pipelines to the place of use which is the ammunition depot grounds located in portions of townships 7 N., Ranges 30 and 31 E.; townships 8 N., Ranges 29, 30 and 31 E.; and townships 9 N., Ranges 30 and 31 E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for municipal and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
