## THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy L. Wilbur has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deep or Big Spring through ditches for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW<sup>1</sup> NE<sup>1</sup> Section 19, T. 18 S., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 19 bears S 39° 24' W, 4,612.8 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.


Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

14.80 acres in the NW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Section 24, T. 18 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.  
2.95 acres in the SW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Section 24, T. 18 S., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M.  
29.85 Acres Total

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
