CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Josie Pearl has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pearl Spring

through spring and pipeline for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW<sup>1</sup> SW<sup>1</sup> Section 25, T. 42 N., R. 27 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 25 bears S. 82° 56' E., 4,230 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Josie Pearl

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0044 c.f.s., or not to exceed 1,440 gallons per day

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 13, 1928

Description of WORKS of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed from a spring whence it is carried by pipeline to a house which is located within the NW<sup>1</sup> NE<sup>1</sup> Section 31, T. 42 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
