CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. A. Liddell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Pahrump Valley) through well, pump, pipeline and ditches for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹ NW¹ Section 23, T. 20 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 23 bears N. 80° 08' W., 1,127 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

40 acres in the SE¹ SE¹ Section 22, T. 20 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M.
40 " " " NE¹ SE¹ " " " " "
155 Acres Total

Portions of this land are also irrigated under other permits and certificates, and the total duty from all sources shall not exceed 5 acre feet per acre per annum.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
