CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring through spring, pipeline and tank for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE¹ NE¹ Section 36, T. 25 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¹ corner of said Section 36 bears S. 23° 31' E., 463 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00409 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2,000 sheep
Period of use, from March 15 to November 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 11, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from Willow Spring whence it is conveyed by pipeline to a metal watering tank which is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and there used to water approximately 650 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
