CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John E. Curran has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and sprinklers for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of Section 9 bears N. 12° 34' W., 3,321.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.0 c.f.s., or not to exceed 671.37 acrefeet per annum.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 27, 1950.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
