CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John E. Curran has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sheep Springs Creek (Flood Waters) through earthen dam and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 21, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Section 21 bears S. 83° 58' W., a distance of 1,172 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Parman Brothers (Vern R. Parman and Ralph G. Parman)
Post-office address: Gerlach, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 5.0 c.f.s. or not to exceed 157.5 acre-feet/ per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 26, 1952.

28.5 acres in Lot 1, Section 15, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.
16.5 " " Lot 2, Section 15, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.

* Portions of this land are also irrigated under other permits and certificates, and the total duty from all sources shall not exceed 3.5 acre feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
