CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles W. Mapes, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source - Well No. 1 through well, pump and pipelines for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 11 bears S. 63° 02' 43" W., 4,364.18 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mapes Hotel Corporation
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.0 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 25, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use to the Mapes Hotel located within N 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 19 N., R. 19 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
