CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter G. Reid has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Truckee River

through dam, headgate and ditches for

irrigation, stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Orr Ditch in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Section 17, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which

the S.W. corner of said Section 17 bears S. 44° 40' W. 3,211 feet.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 1.0 c.f.s. or 150.0 acre-feet per annum.

Period of use, from as decreed to of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 1, 1863

Description of place and manner of use.

As set forth in the Truckee River final decree, as entered by U.S. District Court of Nevada case in equity, Docket A-3, vested under Claim 390.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
