CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles Damele has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, windmill, pipelines and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4, SE 1/4 Section 22, T. 26 N., R. 51 E., M. 30 & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of Section 27, T. 26 N., R. 51 E. bears S. 2° 26' 22" E., 5,597.8 ft. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Stephen Damele and Sons
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.007 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle and twenty-five horses
Period of use, from September 1st to April 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 22, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a well and is pumped to stockwatering troughs within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
