CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Henry C. Houck has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring Canyon through reservoir and pipeline for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Section 1, T. 46 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 1 bears N. 58° 48' E., 204 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 27, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a dam and reservoir and is conveyed by pipeline to the places of use, located within the NW 1/4 Section 13, T. 47 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
