

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Michael Tekla has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

El Dorado Spring

through dam and pipeline for

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 8, T. 28 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 8 bears N. 73° 26' W., 2,362 feet.  
situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed from El Dorado Spring and is impounded by a dam and is conveyed to the place of use within the E 1/2 NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 and N 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 8, T. 28 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
