CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. T. Holcomb has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and pipelines for industrial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: (3 wells), NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 18 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at points from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 40 21' 44" E., 4589.45 feet, S. 00 39' 44" E., 4,621.69 feet and \* (see below) situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Rodeo Wilshire Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: May 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 31, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of drilled wells, and it is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

\* S. 40 20' 47" E., 5,254.52 feet.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
