CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, F. A. Tracy, President, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (Under Claim No. 128) through Highland Ditch for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., 1,650 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533,425, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Sierra Pacific Power Company
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.20 c.f.s. or 49.4 acre-feet per annum.
Period of use, from as decreed to of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 2, 1875

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is delivered from Highland Ditch into Highland Reservoir and thence into distribution mains serving the cities of Reno and Sparks and contiguous areas.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Claim 128, Truckee River Final Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
