

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, EUGENE C. SPROUT has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Peckham Spring

through diversion box, pipe and pond for fish rearing

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 30 T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¹/₄ corner of said Section 30 bears S. 77° 13' 49" W., 1,562.59 feet.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.50 cfs.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 15, 1944

Description of point of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the source by means of a diversion box and is conveyed through a pipeline to the Washoe County Fish Rearing-ponds located within the E¹/₂ NW¹/₄ Section 30, T. 19 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
