

**THE STATE OF NEVADA  
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Richard M. Black has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 8, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 9, T. 43 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 67° 57' E., 2,875 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:
