CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Monahan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground-Las Vegas Artesian Basin through well, pump, tank and pipelines for recreational and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 24, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 24 bears S. 26° 23' 55" E., 1,204.41 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425; has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s.
Period of use, from May 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 5, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the places of use (one acre) located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
