CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lee M. Burge has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump, pipeline and reservoir for fish culture purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 19, N., R. 19 E., M.D.R. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 5° 58' 10" E., 3,013.2 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Washoe County Game Management Board
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.6 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 23, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to ponds located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
