

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Springs through pipelines and watering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, T. 26 N., R. 59 E., M.D.R. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Section 9, T. 26 N., R. 58 E., bears S. 89° 57' W., 44,679 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Ruby Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.046 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 21, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Cherry Springs whence it is carried by pipeline to watering troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
