

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Blair has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Reinken Spring No. 1 through dam, pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 18 N., R. 23 E., M.D.R.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said section 29 bears S. 11° 37' E., 2,558 feet. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 cattle
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation January 28, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring area, whence it is diverted by means of a structure through a pipeline to metal stockwatering troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
