

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Gertrude G. Herrin has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through pump, storage tank and pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 10, T.13, N., R. 18 E., M.D.R.&M., or at a point from which the meander corner common to sections 3 and 10, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., bears N. 16° 20' E., 2,457 feet. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 * Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s.
 * Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation November 4, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from Lake Tahoe by means of a pipeline and pump, thence it is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

* Note: It is understood that in addition to the summer use as designated herein, the permittee will be entitled to intermittent use during the non-summer season on the basis not to exceed fifty gallons of water per capita per day.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
