CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. C. Crofoot has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through sump, pump, truck and reservoir for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 34 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of section 34, T. 35 N., R. 29 E., bears N. 20° 35' W. 1,681 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 26, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a dug sump and impounded therein and is trucked to the place of use which is a mill located within the W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 28, T. 35 N., R. 29 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
