CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wales G. Bramlette has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Queen Spring through spring reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 17, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., M.D.P.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of section 16, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., bears S. 53° 44' E., 240 feet, situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Wales G. Bramlette
Post-office address: Benton, Calif.
Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 2, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring, whence it is impounded in a reservoir, thence conveyed to watering troughs which are located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
