CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Simpson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, tank and pipelines for commercial (trailer court) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said section 15 bears S. 39° 34' E., 2,603 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: W. H. Simpson
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.031 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 15, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed by pipelines to a 22 unit trailer court within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
