CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through dam and reservoir for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 29 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said section 30 bears N. 50° 18' E., 540.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Simplot Iron Mines, Inc.
Post-office address: Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 24, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a trench and dam and is conveyed to the N 1/2 Section 32, T. 29 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
