CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, tank and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 16 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of section 14, T. 16 N., R. 53 E., bears N. 70° 27' W., 18,705 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Wm. A. Bartholomae
Post-office address Brea, California
Amount of appropriation 0.0047 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.
Period of use, from October 15th to May 15th of the following year.
Date of priority of appropriation December 24, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, and is pumped into a concrete storage tank and watering troughs in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
