CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Wm. A. Bartholomae has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Antelope Well No. 8) through well and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, T. 18 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of section 19, T. 18 N., R. 51 E., bears N. 28° 05' W., 9,315 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation: 0.668 c.f.s., or not to exceed 160 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from: April 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 21, 1957

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
40 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 19, T. 18 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M.

* The land under this certificate is also irrigated from other sources and the total duty of water from all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
