CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mat H. Gibbons has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground sources (3 artesian wells) through drilled wells and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 11, T. 30 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.25 c.f.s., or not to exceed 53.56 acre feet per season.

Period of use, from March 1st to November 1st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 23, 1925

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
