Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within the same subdivision as is the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
