CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward L. Pine has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, tank and pipeline for air-conditioning and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said section 11 bears S. 63° 08' 22" W., 4,206.76 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 2, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped through an air conditioning system in the Masonic Temple Building located within the same subdivision as is the point of diversion. The surplus water is returned to the Truckee River.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
