CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James M. Daniels has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pillar Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4, NE 1/4 Section 10, T. 8 S., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of section 1, T. 8 S., R. 47 E., bears S. 63° 33' W., 12,798 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James M. Daniels
Post-office address Goldfield, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 6, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a spring and piped to a rock basin within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
