

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Malvin Pedrolì has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through pipeline to trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T. 36 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of section 18 T. 36 N., R. 39 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 27° 01' W., 16,691.00 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation .0025 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 80 cattle and horses.
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation November 20, 1950

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a spring by means of a pipeline to a galvanized trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and is there used to water 80 cattle and horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
