CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harry H. Hughes has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 4 S., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed or at a point from which Post No. 72 on California-Nevada Stateline bears S. 78° 00' W., 31,445.0 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ernest M. Pellkofer, et ux.
Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.010 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 320 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 10, 1947

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to a watering trough located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for watering 320 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
