CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. P. Osgood, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (2 wells) through wells and ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source are as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., or at points from which the N.W. corner of said Section 26 bears N. 82° 13' W., 1,565 ft. and N. 88° 19' W., 2,570 ft. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 1.2 c.f.s., or not to exceed 654.5 acre feet.

Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:

Table with 8 columns: Acres, SW, SE, NW, NE, Section, T., R., M.D.B.&M. Rows list various land parcels including 25.6 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 23, T. 37 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M., and a total of 352.2 Acres.

* The land under this certificate is also irrigated by other sources, and the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
