CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul T. Quick, Acting Regional Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Horse Canyon Spring No. 2 through dam, ditches and reservoir for wild life and stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 45 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 30 bears S. 38° 55' W., 1.112 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States Fish and Wildlife Service
Post-office address: Portland, Oregon
Amount of appropriation: 0.010 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 2, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a spring and is conveyed by a ditch to the place of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
