CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bertrand Arambel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, Arambel Well No. 2, through well, pump, tank and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 11 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.E. corner of Section 1, T. 11 N., R. 52 E., bears S. 57° 58' W., 2,164.0 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0134 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 2,000 sheep.
Period of use, from February 15th to March 15th and October 15th to December 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 4, 1946

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to watering troughs located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and is there used for watering 2,000 sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
