CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. Wendell Jones has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from snow and flood waters of Black Canyon Wash through ditches, dam and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 2 S., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 67 E., bears N. 86° 50' E., 25,308 feet. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Wm. L. Jones, Lehi M. Jones and H. Wendell Jones

Post-office address Cedar City, Utah.

Amount of appropriation 1/2 acre feet or sufficient for 5400 sheep.

Period of use, from October 10th to May 1st of the following year.

Date of priority of appropriation December 24, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a diversion dam and is impounded in an earthen reservoir and conveyed to metal stockwatering troughs. The places of use are in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of said Section 17.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
