CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. Tyson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through return well for air conditioning purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the center quarter corner of said Section 4 bears S. 24° 26' 23" E., 1,384.2 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The well under this certificate is a return well for the waters pumped for air conditioning purposes under Permit No. 10986.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
