CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Big Bob Cross-cut Tunnel) through diversion box and pipelines for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 44 N., R. 52 E., M.D.R. & M. or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 30 bears N. 35° 22' 17" W., 4,620.90 feet. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from the Big Bob Cross-cut tunnel; collected in diversion box at the mouth of the tunnel and piped to the place of use located in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 30, T. 44 N., R. 52 E., M.D.R. & M.

* The water under this permit is used in conjunction with the water under Permit No. 13924.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
