

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. J. Koval has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for quasi-municipal (trailer court) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.R. & M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 21 bears S. 6° 36' 36" W., 1,134.95 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. or 1.6 m.g. annually
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, whence it is pumped through a distribution system to the places of use located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for quasi-municipal purposes to service 30 trailers.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
