CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jack Doyle has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through pump, well, tank and pipelines for recreational and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 16 bears N. 44° 52' E., 283 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Wilbur Clark's Desert Inn, Co.
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.34 c.f.s., or 272 a.f. annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 9, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a distribution system to a golf course at Wilbur Clark's Desert Inn within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

Land to which water is appurtenant:
68 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion under Permit No. 13711.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
