CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Norman H. Pleger has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for quasi-municipal (resort hotel) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the center corner of said Section 29 bears N. 67° 38' 56" W., 1,335.0 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The National Corporation
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
\* Amount of appropriation: 0.25 c.f.s., or 60 m.g. annually
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 14, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, whence it is pumped through a distribution system to the place of use located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

\* Total use under both Applications, No's. 16384 and 16385.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
