CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Beatrice Halstead has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Summit Spring through storage tank and pipelines for domestic (school) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Section 21, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., bears S. 28° 53' 03" W., 12,235.73 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 8, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring and piped to a storage tank, thence it is conveyed by pipeline to the place of use which consists of school facilities--located in the W 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
