CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. B. Spencer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well No. 2) through pump and Hawthorne water system for domestic use and municipal supply purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 8 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 27 bears S. 78° 56' W., 895.7 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of Hawthorne
Post-office address: Hawthorne, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.31 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 30, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped directly into a distribution system for general use of domestic needs that a town requires. Place of use is all of Section 27, T. 8 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
