CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Marion E. Yelland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Shingle Creek through pipeline and ditches for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 13 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 22, T. 13 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 72° 59' W., 14,730 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Marion E., Louis Kent, Richard Henry, William Phillips and John Louis Yelland, co-partners. Post-office address: Spring Valley via Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 1,593 c.f.s., or not to exceed 640 ac.ft. per season. Period of use, from March 20th to November 20th of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 27, 1954

Description of land to which water is appurtenant: 160 acres in SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 13 N., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
