CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Julian Goicoechea has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through pipe to stock tank for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 22 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 15 bears S. 32° 20' W., 679.0 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Julian Goicoechea
Post-office address Newark Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 cattle and 1250 sheep.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 16, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a seismographic blast hole and is conveyed by pipe to a stock tank located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
