CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Seminario has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pinto Peak Spring through dam, trench, pipeline and trough for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 34 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. Corner of said Section 2 bears N. 38° 51' E., 1,263 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 500 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 10, 1957

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is collected by means of a dam, thence into trenches, a pipeline and into a 500 gal. trough in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
