CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert S. Leighton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (Claim Nos. 467 & 468) through dam, ditch, reservoir and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., 1,650 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from As decreed of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 1, 1862

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the Truckee River to the Highland Reservoir by means of the Highland Ditch and is conveyed to the cities of Reno and Sparks and contiguous areas through a distribution system.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of portions of Claim Nos. 467 and 468, Truckee River Final Decree.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
