CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dewey Dann has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through open cut, pipeline, ditch, reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 10, T. 28 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Sec. 3, T. 28 N., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 24° 35' 50" W., 6,050.8 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Dewey Dann
Post-office address: Beowawe, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.006 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 180 cattle
Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 27, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of an open cut and conveyed by means of a pipe and ditch to a stock reservoir located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
