CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert S. Leighton, Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from The Truckee River (Claim 413) through dam, ditch, reservoir and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 19 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., 1,650 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.169 c.f.s., or not to exceed 41.31 ac.ft. annually
Period of use, from: As Decreed to:
Date of priority of appropriation: December 1, 1862

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the Truckee River to the Highland Reservoir by means of the Highland Ditch and is conveyed to the cities of Reno and Sparks and contiguous areas through a distribution system.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use on a portion of Claim 413, Truckee River Final Decree, Docket A-3.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
